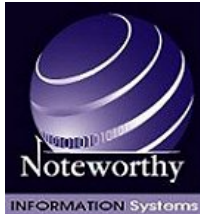

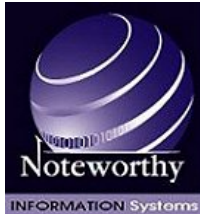
Joe McAdams, East Coast Technical Manager

Project Description
